The Bacardi Rum Distillery is located in the town of Cataño, just across the Bay from Old San Juan. The first stop will be at an open air pavilion where you will receive a complimentary drink. Once you have relaxed, the tour begins aboard a trolley that transports you to Casa Bacardi where you are shown the entire process of rum making, from fermentation, to mixing, and bottling and explore more than 130 years of tradition.

Afterwards, you will be taken on a walking tour of Old San Juan where you'll discover 500 years of fascinating history. Your next stop will be at San Cristobal Fortress, which in colonial times protected the island from enemy attacks. Walk through of the impressive fortress and then take a walking guided tour down the promontory of the Old City.
